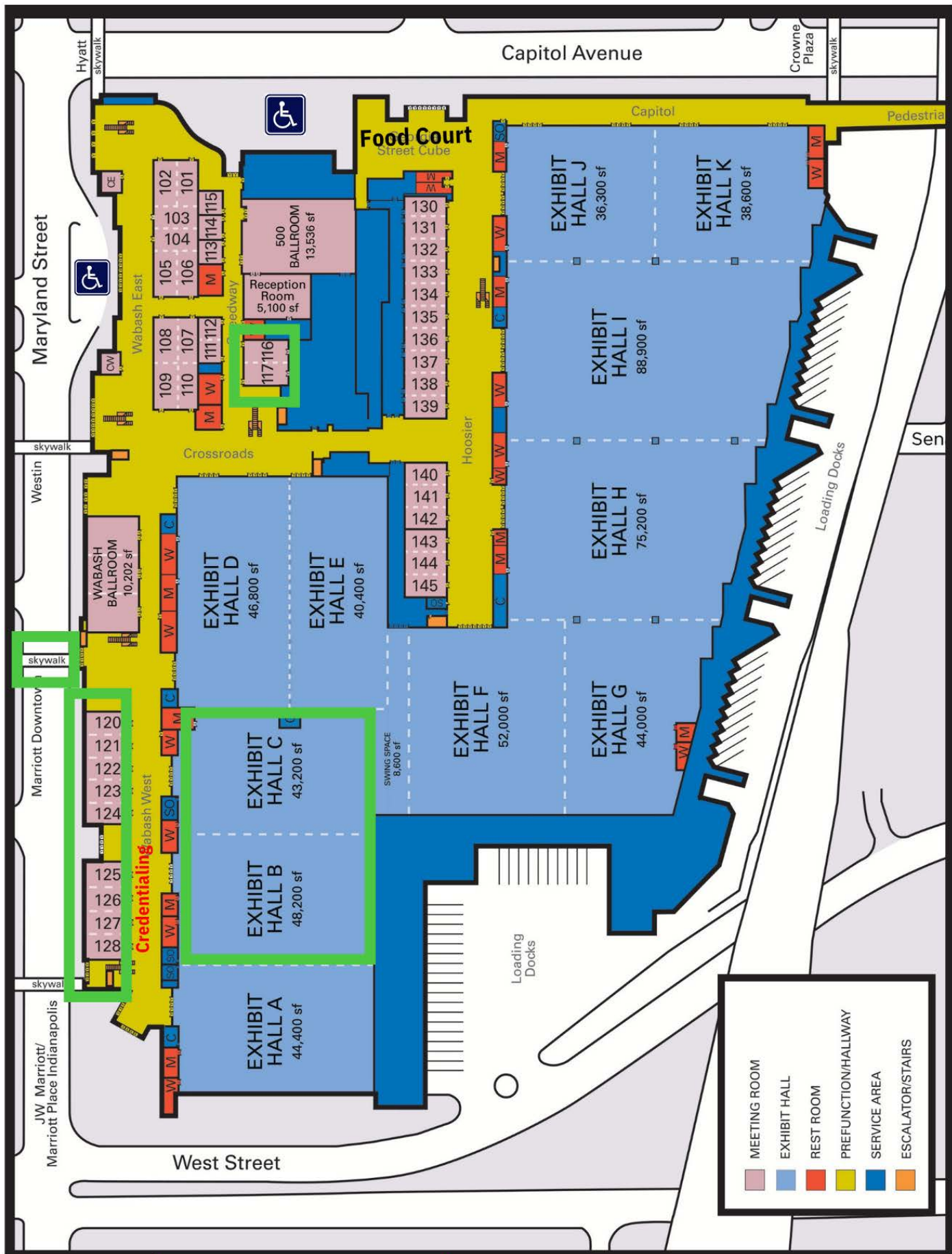

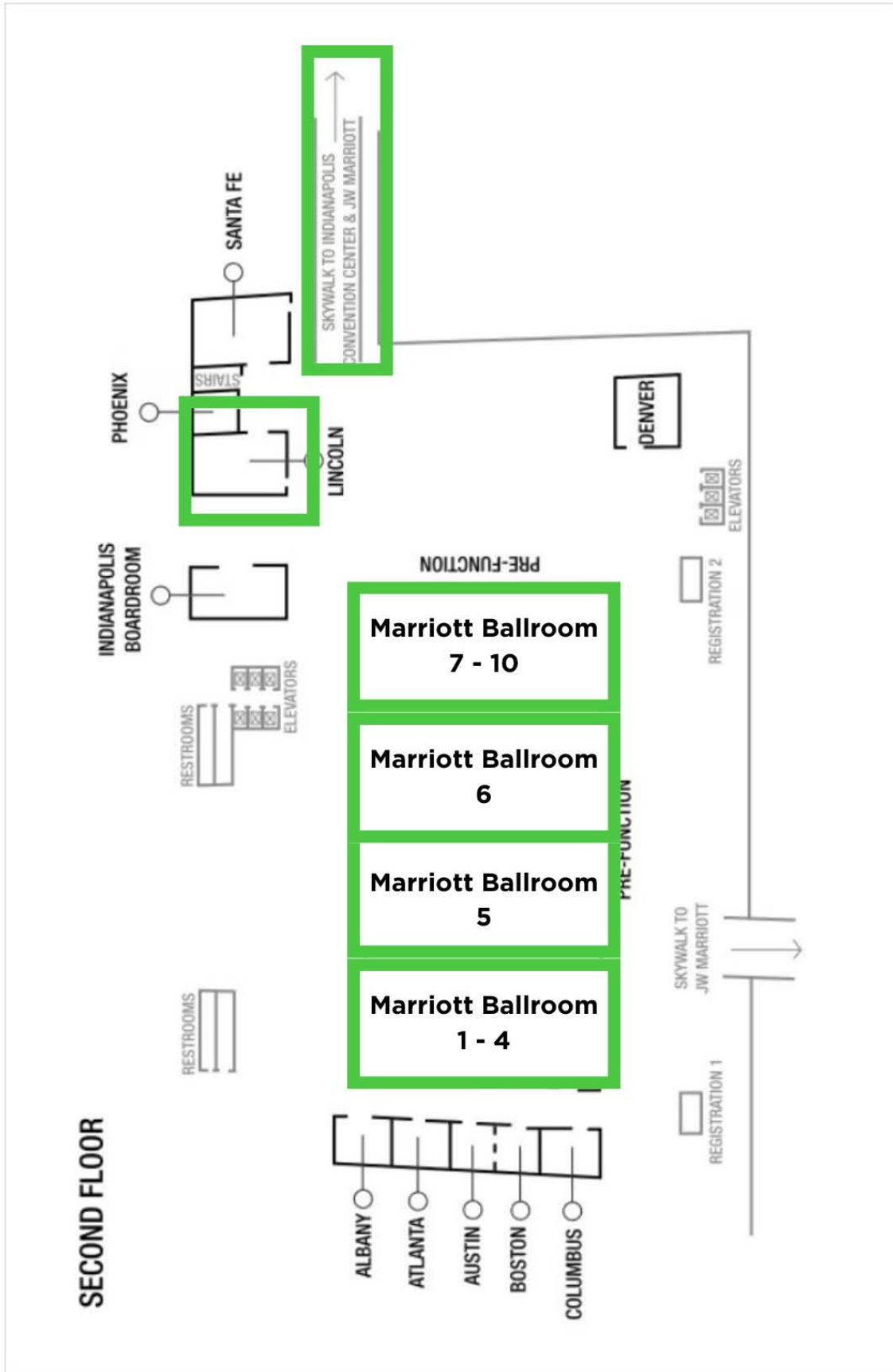

CALL TO THE 2026 STATE CONVENTION OF THE INDIANA DEMOCRATIC PARTY

May 12, 2026

Dear Fellow Democrat,

You are receiving the Call to Convention (Call) because you were either elected or appointed to represent your county as a delegate to our upcoming State Convention. The Call details the rules and procedures for the convention which will be held on June 6, 2026, at the Indiana Convention Center and the Indianapolis Marriott Downtown. Please continue to check the State Party website for updates on Convention details at <https://indems.org/2026-state-convention-central/>, and note that there will be caucus meetings starting earlier in the day. We look forward to seeing you in June!

WHEREAS, Indiana law and the Rules of the Indiana Democratic Party (“State Party”) require the State Party to hold a State Convention (“Convention”) every two years at a time and place set by the Indiana Democratic Party’s State Central Committee (the “State Committee”); and

WHEREAS, Indiana law requires the State Party to nominate at its State Convention candidates for Secretary of State, State Comptroller, and State Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, the Rules of the State Party require the Party in congressional district caucuses to elect one member to the State Convention Committees on Rules*, Resolutions**, and Credentials, and one vice-president of the State Convention, one assistant secretary of the State Convention, and one assistant sergeant-at-arms of the State Convention; and

WHEREAS, the Rules of the State Party and the Temporary Rules of the 2026 State Convention, as approved by the State Central Committee, require all candidates for Secretary of State, State Comptroller, and State Treasurer to file with the Indiana Democratic Party before noon EDT, Friday, May 22, and district representatives to the State Convention Committees on Rules, Resolutions, and Credentials elected at the State Convention to file with the Indiana Democratic Party before noon EDT, Friday, April 24;

WHEREAS, due to the rare circumstances that the primary election falls close to the deadline to sending the Call to Convention, the State Central Committee suspended the Rules of the State Party requiring a Call to the State Convention at least thirty (30) days prior to the convening of said Convention at the February 7, 2026 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the State Party is issuing a Call to the State Convention prior to the convening of said Convention.

NOW, LET IT BE SAID, THEREFORE, that I, the Indiana Democratic State Party Chair, do hereby issue the following Call to the 2026 Indiana Democratic State Convention:

Paid for by the Indiana Democratic State Central Committee, www.indems.org.
Not authorized by any candidate or candidate’s committee.

1. The Convention General Session of the State Party will be convened at 1:30 PM EDT (Indianapolis time), on Saturday, June 6, 2026, at the Indiana Convention Center, 100 S. Capitol Avenue in Indianapolis, Indiana.
2. The State Chair, with the approval of the State Central Committee, made all arrangements for the Convention.
3. Congressional district caucus meetings of the state delegates to the Convention will take place at 9:00 AM EDT (Indianapolis time), on June 6, 2026, at the Indiana Convention Center and the Indianapolis Marriott in Indianapolis, Indiana.
4. The names of all duly elected delegates to the Convention, by law, are forwarded to the State Party by the County Clerk of the County in which the elected delegates reside. All elected delegates to the Convention who cannot attend the Convention must make notification in writing of their intention to be absent to the County Chair of the County in which they reside. The County Chair will then certify and authorize the elected alternate. The County Chair will also submit to the State Party names to fill state delegate vacancies. Names of alternates and delegate vacancies must be filed with the State Party no later than 5:00 P.M. EDT Friday, May 22, 2026.
5. Per the Temporary Rules for the 2026 State Convention, all candidates for the Democratic nomination for Secretary of State, State Comptroller, and State Treasurer to file with the Indiana Democratic Party before noon EDT, Friday, May 22, 2026, and district representatives to the State Convention Committees on Rules, Resolutions, and Credentials elected at the State Convention must file with the Indiana Democratic Party before 12:00 PM EDT, Friday, April 24 2026. Filings started to be accepted on April 7, 2026. Any candidate may withdraw their name as a candidate at any time prior to nomination. The State Chair may reject any declaration or application of any candidate for any office if the State Chair determines that the candidate is not affiliated with the Indiana Democratic Party.
6. Election for the Democratic nomination for Secretary of State, State Comptroller, and State Treasurer shall, if contested, be on Indiana Election Commission certified election equipment.
7. Constituency Caucus meetings of state delegates to the Convention will take place at 10:30 AM EDT (Indianapolis time), on Saturday, June 6, 2026, at the Indiana Convention Center and Indianapolis Marriott in Indianapolis, Indiana. The following caucus meetings are already planned – College Democrats, Young Democrats, African-American Caucus, Stonewall Democrats, Latino Caucus, Labor Caucus, and Women’s Council.
8. The State Committee of the Indiana Democratic Party shall meet to conduct State Convention-related business June 5, 2026, at 12:00 PM EDT in downtown Indianapolis. Final details will be on our website.
9. The State Committee approved 2,560 state delegates amongst the 92 counties.
10. Official results of the congressional district caucus elections will be announced at the Convention.
11. Official results of the election for the State Party’s nomination of Secretary of State, State Comptroller, and State Treasurer will be announced at the Convention and transmitted to the Secretary of State of the State of Indiana.

** Draft resolutions to be considered by the Resolutions Committee of the Convention should be submitted with the required 550 signatures by 5:00 PM EDT on Wednesday, June 3 to Resolutions@indems.org for review and distribution to members of the Temporary Resolutions Committee prior to the State Convention.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Credentialing

- Delegates must pick up their credentials by 9:00 A.M. EDT on Saturday, June 6, 2026, at the designated area in the Indiana Convention Center. No delegate credentials will be distributed after that time. County Chairs may gather their delegation's credentials prior to the pick-up deadline if the Chair signs for the credentials and informs State Party Staff by 3:00 PM EDT Friday, June 5, 2026.

Resolutions Procedures

- Resolutions for consideration should be submitted to Resolutions@indems.org by 5:00 PM EDT on Wednesday, June 3, 2026.
- Per the Temporary Rules of the State Convention:
 - a) Both the Temporary and Permanent Resolutions Committee members may sponsor a resolution. Members do not need to fulfill the signature requirement as outlined in b.
 - b) Delegates wishing to offer a resolution for consideration may submit a proposal to be considered by the Temporary Resolutions Committee. Such resolutions require a minimum of 550 delegate signatures and must be submitted by Wednesday, June 3, 2026 by 5 P.M. to resolutions@indems.org.
 - c) In order to give adequate time for obtaining signatures, a delegate wishing to submit a resolution may request from the State Chair the final list of delegates that was provided to candidates by the May 29 deadline.
 - d) Temporary Resolutions Committee shall meet on Friday, June 5, 2026, at 3 P.M. and shall prepare a report for the Permanent Resolutions Committee. Resolutions considered by the Temporary Resolutions Committee and found to be meritorious by a two-thirds majority of the members shall be included in the Report of the Resolutions Committee.
 - e) The Permanent Resolutions Committee shall meet on Saturday, June 6, 2026, at 10:30 A.M. The Permanent Resolutions Committee shall consider all resolutions in the report, but they may also consider other resolutions offered by the Permanent Resolutions Committee. The Permanent Resolutions Committee may ratify or amend the report by a two-thirds majority.



TEMPORARY RULES OF THE INDIANA DEMOCRATIC PARTY'S 2026 STATE CONVENTION

1. These temporary rules (“Temporary Rules”) apply to the Indiana Democratic Party’s 2026 State Convention (“Convention”) as provided herein. These Temporary Rules have been duly adopted by the Indiana Democratic State Central Committee (“State Central Committee”) pursuant to the Rules of the Indiana Democratic Party.
2. The Secretary of the State Central Committee shall certify to the Permanent Chair of this Convention the names of all candidates for any office who have filed declarations of candidacy or applications in the office of the Indiana Democratic Party (“State Party”). Such certification shall constitute notice to the Convention of all persons who have filed such declarations of candidacy or applications. In making such certification to the Convention, the Secretary shall name the candidate, the county, and district in which such candidate resides, and the office to which such candidate aspires.
3. With respect to qualifications and eligibility:
 - a) All candidates for any statewide office (Secretary of State, Treasurer of State, or State Comptroller) nominated at the Convention shall file a declaration of candidacy with the Indiana Democratic Party on or before NOON on Friday, April 24, 2026. Declarations of candidacy will be accepted for filing beginning April 6, 2026. The original notarized declaration of candidacy forms must be filed with the Indiana Democratic Party by the deadline set above. If no candidate has filed for a specific office (Secretary of State, Treasurer of State, or State Comptroller), then the deadline is extended to NOON on Friday, May 22, 2026.
 - b) Any candidate may withdraw his or her name as a candidate at any time prior to nomination.
 - c) The State Chair of the State Party (“State Chair”) may reject the declaration of candidacy or application of any candidate for any office if the State Chair, in consultation with district and county party committees, determines that the candidate is not affiliated with the Indiana Democratic Party.
 - d) Following the primary election, the State Chair will provide each candidate the elected delegate list within seven (7) days after the primary election, that includes: VANID, Congressional District, County, Type of Delegate (appointed, elected, automatic), Position (county chair, district secretary, etc.), First Name, Middle Initial, Last Name, Address; Phone, Email. The final list of appointed delegates will be provided by the State Chair as they are received and processed. A final list of changes will be provided by May 29, 2026.
 - e) Statewide office (Secretary of State, Treasurer of State, or State Comptroller) will

require a filing fee to be paid by May 22, 2026. Filing fees are assessed as follows:

- Secretary of State: \$5,000
- Treasurer of State: \$5,000
- State Comptroller: \$5,000

4. When there is no contest for an office, the nomination or election may be made by a motion by the Permanent Chair of the Convention or by acclamation of the Convention.

5. There shall be allowed three (3) minutes for a nomination speech for the offices of Secretary of State, Treasurer of State, and State Comptroller, unless the Permanent Chair of the Convention approves longer times. The Permanent Chair will then ask for a second to the nomination from the floor. The nominating speeches for candidates shall be in order as the candidate's names are listed on the voting machines, which shall be in alphabetical order. The Secretary of State, Treasurer of State, and State Comptroller nominees will then have three (3) minutes for an acceptance speech.

6. No one shall be allowed on the floor of the Convention where the delegates are located while any vote is being taken except delegates, party officials, election officers and voting machine assistants as may be duly appointed by the State Chair and necessary to conduct such elections, watchers representing the candidates during the time the votes are cast, and other properly credentialed individuals.

7. A Temporary Chair of the Convention shall be appointed by the State Chair, subject to approval by the State Central Committee. The Temporary Chair shall open the Convention and preside over all such matters coming before the Convention until such time as the Temporary Chair relinquishes the gavel to the Permanent Chair of the Convention.

8. The State Central Committee shall report to the Convention the duly adopted Temporary Rules of the 2026 State Convention. The Committee on Rules and Permanent Organization shall report the Temporary Rules to the Delegates. The Temporary Rules shall be made Permanent by the Convention by voice vote upon a motion by the Temporary or Permanent Chair. The Committee on Rules and Permanent Organization shall meet on June 6, 2026, at 10:30 A.M. to formally adopt the Temporary Rules passed by the State Central Committee.

9. The State Central Committee shall appoint a Temporary Credentials Committee that shall serve until a Permanent Credentials Committee is elected at District Caucuses on June 6, 2026. The Permanent Credentials Committee shall report to the Convention the total number of eligible delegates, the total number of delegates present (credentialed as of 10:30 A.M., June 6, 2026, by congressional district) and the presence or absence of a quorum. The report of the Permanent Credentials Committee shall be adopted by the Convention by voice vote upon a motion by the Temporary Chair.

10. Credentials Procedure:

- a) County Chairs shall submit their appointed delegate and alternate lists to the State

Chair no later than 5:00 P.M. Friday, May 22, 2026. Credentials will be distributed to County Chairs or their designees, whose county delegate assessments have been paid by NOON on Friday, June 5, 2026. The State Chair or the Temporary Credentials Committee by majority vote may seat individual delegates or delegations from counties making late payments after the June 6, 2026, deadline. No County delegation shall be seated at the Convention if the County is in arrears with the State Party.

b) The Temporary Credentials Committee shall meet on Friday June 5, 2026 at 3:00 P.M. to adopt the official poll list of delegates and alternates eligible to vote at the Convention and to resolve any preliminary credentialing issues. Any challenges to the official poll list must be submitted to the Temporary Chair by 11:30 A.M. on Saturday, June 6, 2026. The Permanent Credentials Committee shall review and resolve all challenges at their meeting on June 6, 2026, at 1:00 P.M.

c) It shall be the responsibility of each County Chair to:

- i) Distribute credentials to the persons entitled to those credentials;
- ii) Certify to the Temporary Credentials Committee no later than 3:00 P.M. on Friday, June 5, 2026, the names of the individuals who hold the credentials, identifying those persons from the list of elected delegates, or a list of the certified elected alternates in possession of the State Central Committee.
- iii) Make changes in the composition of the county delegation only with the approval of the Temporary Credentials Committee after 3:00 P.M. Friday, June 5, 2026.

d) The names of duly authorized Convention delegates and alternates shall be compiled into official lists, which will be distributed to candidates and to the voting machine inspectors and clerks for use as a voter poll list at such machines.

11. Elected delegates who appear in person and who have been replaced by an alternate shall have precedence over an alternate up to the time of printing of the final poll list at 10:30 A.M. on June 6, 2026, and subject to compliance with all applicable rules of the Convention, and approved by the Credentials Committee.

12. The State Central Committee shall appoint a Temporary Resolutions Committee that shall serve until a Permanent Resolutions Committee is elected at District Caucuses on June 6, 2026. The report of the Permanent Resolutions Committee shall be adopted by the Convention by voice vote upon a motion by the Temporary Chair of the Convention.

13. Resolutions Procedure:

- a) Both the Temporary and Permanent Resolutions Committee members may sponsor a resolution. Members do not need to fulfill the signature requirement as outlined in b.
- b) Delegates wishing to offer a resolution for consideration may submit a proposal to be considered by the Temporary Resolutions Committee. Such resolutions require a minimum of 550 delegate signatures and must be submitted by Wednesday, June 3,

2026 by 5 P.M. to resolutions@indems.org.

- c) In order to give adequate time for obtaining signatures, a delegate wishing to submit a resolution may request from the State Chair the final list of delegates that was provided to candidates by the May 29 deadline.
- d) Temporary Resolutions Committee shall meet on Friday, June 5, 2026, at 3 P.M. and shall prepare a report for the Permanent Resolutions Committee. Resolutions considered by the Temporary Resolutions Committee and found to be meritorious by a two-thirds majority of the members shall be included in the Report of the Resolutions Committee.
- e) The Permanent Resolutions Committee shall meet on June 6, 2026, at 10:30 A.M. The Permanent Resolutions Committee shall consider all resolutions in the report, but they may also consider other resolutions offered by the Permanent Resolutions Committee. The Permanent Resolutions Committee may ratify or amend the report by a two-thirds majority.

14. The 2026 Platform of the Indiana Democratic Party shall be approved by the majority of the State Central Committee at their meeting on June 5, 2026 at NOON. The 2026 Platform shall be adopted by the Convention by voice vote upon a motion by the Temporary Chair.

15. All candidates for a state office where there is a contest shall have their names placed on the voting machines, in alphabetical order by last name.

16. Any candidate for any office receiving a majority of the votes cast by those delegates present and voting for that office on any ballot shall be considered nominated.

17. After the first ballot has been taken for any office and no candidate has received a majority of the votes cast by those delegates present and voting, commencing with the second ballot thereafter, the candidate having the lowest votes for said office shall be eliminated until such time as a candidate shall receive a majority of said votes for said office.

18. If there is a tie between candidates, the State Central Committee shall convene an emergency meeting at State Convention to decide any tie between the candidates via secret ballot.

- a) This special meeting shall convene before the call of the closing gavel at convention. A recess shall be called at the State Convention to allow for time for the full State Central Committee to convene. No other business will be conducted at this meeting. The only purpose is to vote and adjourn the meeting.
- b) Each State Central Committee member shall submit a proxy via email to the state party secretary by noon on the day of the convention if they will not be present for the full convention.
- c) A meeting room that is reserved for convention purposes at the convention site will be used for this special meeting. Each candidate is allowed to be present for this vote, and each may name a watcher to observe the tally of the votes. No speeches or electioneering will be allowed in this meeting.
- d) Each State Central Committee member will be given a blank piece of paper to

write their selection. These will be collected by the State Central Committee parliamentarian. With the candidate watchers observing, the parliamentarian and another appointee of the State Chair will calculate the vote totals. The winner's name will be announced to State Central Committee members. Once this is done, the convention will reconvene to announce the winner to all delegates.

e) The State Chair shall break a tie vote.

19. Procedure on the floor shall be as follows: A clerk will be present with a list of the eligible delegates as of 3:00 P.M., June 6, 2026. The delegate may be asked to provide their name, county, and home address. The delegate will then be verified and the clerk shall inform the individual that they may vote.

20. Each candidate in a contested race is entitled to one poll watcher per machine whose name shall be submitted in writing to the Chief Inspector not later than NOON on June 5, 2026.

21. Delegates will be seated on the floor of the Convention by Congressional District. Standard rules of decorum will be observed.

22. Any motion made from the floor of the Convention determined to be in order shall be subject to two, one-minute rounds of debate and then be voted upon by voice vote with a majority required for passage.

23. The rules governing this Convention may be suspended or amended by a two-thirds majority vote of the Convention.

24. Minority reports are governed by Indiana Democratic Party Rule 17(a)(10).

25. Except where inconsistent with the Temporary Rules, the Rules of the Indiana Democratic Party apply. Except where inconsistent with these Temporary Rules or the Rules of the Indiana Democratic Party, Roberts Rules of Order will apply.

26. All references to deadlines and times within these rules shall refer to local time in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Hoosiers absolutely know that, after 20 years of Republican rule, utility rates are skyrocketing, rent is increasing, mortgage foreclosures are double the national average, and childcare is growing more and more scarce. Hospitals are closing their doors while insurance rates balloon past affordable. We deserve better! That's why Indiana Democrats are pushing back against the outrageous actions of both the state and national governments and offering common-sense solutions to make Indiana a better place to live.

Instead of playing political games with Hoosiers' lives like mid-decade redistricting, protecting masked agents and dismantling affordable healthcare, Democrats are coming to the table with common-sense, Hoosier-backed solutions.

- Indiana leaders like U.S. Congressmen André Carson and Frank Mrvan stand up for policies to keep faith with Hoosier workers and ensure jobs stay in the U.S. They demand government accountability by supporting policies that unmask ICE agents and require body cameras. They're defending the constitution by opposing deadly and costly wars started unilaterally by a rogue president.
- Your legislators in the Senate and House of Representatives Democratic caucuses author targeted bills to get rents under control, take pressure off utility bills, protect access to health care and support child care so parents can work. Affordability for Every Hoosier

Hoosiers have been crushed under the burden of high inflation and crushing costs of living driven by Trump's tariffs. Every policy Indiana Democrats champion is rooted in the real stories and struggles shared by our constituents. We stand up for those who are doing everything right but still falling behind.

Reduce Healthcare Costs - Access to healthcare is not a luxury, but a human right. No Hoosier should be denied care because they don't earn enough or live close enough. Yet, Republicans actually shut down the federal government to deny 364,000 Hoosiers access to the ACA, doubling their insurance premiums. And still insurance company profits rise at record rates. Indiana Democrats support guaranteed affordable healthcare coverage and access to necessary care for every Hoosier, including a robust public option and aggressive action to reduce prescription, hospital and insurance costs.

- Fully restore health insurance subsidies to lower costs for Hoosier patients.
- Implement a universal public health insurance option.
- Extend prescription price negotiations beyond just Medicaid.
- Require insurance companies and pharmacies to pass any savings from prescription rebates or hospital cost reductions back to the consumer.
- Provide relief to Hoosiers burdened with medical debt by prohibiting liens on their primary residence as a means of collection, requiring hospitals to offer payment plans and capping the amount of monthly payments for low-income patients.

Lower Utility Bills - A Republican majority has stood by while Hoosier utility bills increase far beyond affordability and Indiana climbs to third in the nation for shutoffs. You have made your voices loud and clear about these hardships. This is why elected Democrats continue to champion legislation to lower your bills and keep utility companies beholden to you, not Wall Street.

- Eliminate the 7% sales tax on utilities.
- Enact a moratorium on utility rate hikes.
- End the 50-year tax breaks for data centers, require them to pay for their own utility and water use, mandate they report to the community on the amount of water and electricity they plan to use, and ensure they offset impacts to neighbors

- Repeal Republican bills that prohibit coal plants from restructuring to renewable energy sources - a change that even large utility corporations say will save consumers money.

Improve Access to Housing - Under Republican control, property taxes and rent continue to increase while housing stock stays limited, as a result Indiana leads the nation in evictions. The Republican supermajority big “fix” saves the average household just over \$200 a year - not even enough to cover a car payment or help with the cost of groceries. Calling this “property tax reform” is absurd. Indiana Democrats offer policies for stronger tenant protections, price-gouging penalties, more affordable housing production, rehabilitation of vacant properties, restrictions on corporate landlord abuse, and stronger code enforcement against negligent landlords. These meaningful solutions are focused on keeping Hoosiers in their homes - affordably.

- Create a path to first time home ownership with buyer tax breaks.
- Increase the renters’ tax deduction and crack down on negligent landlords by allowing tenants to hold rent until they make essential repairs.
- Allow faith institutions to build affordable housing units on their property and reduce restrictions on building tiny homes on personal property for in-law suites.
- Prohibit out-of-state investors from buying up housing stock to rent out for corporate gain and not community investment.
- Offer legal resources to tenants when facing abusive landlords that don't keep properties up to statutory health and safety standards.
- Incentivise building affordable housing on vacant properties.

Education and an Economy that Work for Workers

Treat Childcare as Essential - Access to childcare and Pre-K is the foundation of a strong economy. Without it, parents cannot work, businesses suffer and brain drain accelerates. Yet, Indiana only has childcare spots for 41% of the children who need them, which is why almost 60% of Hoosier parents have had to cut work hours or leave their jobs. This isn't sustainable for families or the economy. While Republicans continue to say the state doesn't have solutions, Democrats are standing up for parents.

- Fully fund the Child Care Development Fund to eliminate the waitlist and ensure low-income families can afford to get to work.
- Implement universal pre-k for 3 and 4 year olds.
- Improve childcare worker pay.
- Require the private sector to invest in solutions that benefit their employees.

Fully Fund Public Schools and Better Pay for Teachers - The Democrats have been sounding the alarm on a full-blown Republican attack on public schools and teachers. Indiana's public schools educate 90% of our students and yet Republicans have stripped over \$500 million from them to fund voucher expansions. Money that could be used to implement statewide Pre-K. By banning books and regulating speech, they violate 1st Amendment protections while making teachers targets of baseless complaints and public attacks. This is not how we encourage our children to learn or help prepare them for a 21st century workforce. Democrats remain committed to fully supporting public schools and teachers.

- Raise starting teacher salaries to \$60,000 to help slow the loss of teachers to other states and careers while also raising the average teacher salary as Indiana's current average teacher salary ranks 38th in the country and 2nd to last when compared with our neighboring states (IL, OH, MI, KY, WI).
- Repeal the Republican immigration bill that makes schools less safe by authorizing them as targets of ICE-led crackdowns.
- Fully fund public schools.
- Require all schools at a certain free and reduced lunch threshold to apply for corporation-wide free and reduced lunch.
- Reign in costly vouchers that have directed public school dollars to private schools with little oversight or academic expectations.

Implement Paid Family Leave - Paid family leave programs allow workers to still be paid while taking time off to care for a new child or aging parent. They help businesses retain skilled workers, improve maternal and infant health outcomes, reduce the risks of families falling into poverty, and are supported by over 75% of Americans. Fewer than ¼ of Hoosiers have access to paid family leave and many workers cannot afford to take unpaid leave. And yet, the Republicans keep refusing to hear the Indiana Democrats' bills to establish such a program.

- Incentivize employers to create paid family leave programs.
- Create a statewide family leave program funded through very small payroll tax contributions.

Create More High Paying Jobs IN Indiana- At \$7.25 an hour Indiana's minimum wage is the lowest pay permitted by the federal government. At this rate, a Hoosier would have to work three full time jobs to afford a two bedroom apartment. Our stagnant wages contribute to Indiana having the highest foreclosure rate in the nation. Despite Republicans touting Indiana as "open for business," we lose critical opportunities because without childcare, Pre-K, strong public schools, parks, and thriving neighborhoods, businesses cannot recruit workers to our state. Businesses have been

saying this, Republicans do not listen. Democrats understand a strong economy is built by workers, not CEOs.

- Raise Indiana's minimum wage to a livable amount such that Hoosiers working full time can at least afford the basics of living.
- Invest in community improvement initiatives, keep public schools strong, focus on public health and well being, fix our roads, and provide resources to build and maintain parks and greenspaces.
- Continue the fight to ensure U.S. companies stay U.S. companies, and make it a financial disadvantage for corporations to ship jobs overseas.
- Champion unions by supporting workers, encouraging organizing and expanding union rights. This is how we ensure workers earn the high pay and benefits reflective of their hard work.
- Demand that economic development initiatives benefit the workers and communities more than Wall Street. Economic development must pay for its own utilities, provide neighborhood investments, and ensure local residents fill the available jobs.
- Support policies to eliminate taxes on tips and overtime.

Revitalize Rural Communities - Our rural communities have unfortunately borne the brunt of difficult economic times. Nine rural hospitals have closed in the last ten years, and 16 OBGYN centers in the last six. Farmers have silos full of crops they can't sell because of Trump's chaotic Tariffs. Rural schools continue to be robbed to fund voucher programs in more urban areas. There was a time when rural communities thrived in Indiana, and Hoosier Democrats have a plan for bringing vital resources and opportunities back to these important areas.

- Repeal Governor Braun's policy prohibiting hospitals that accept Medicaid to use a nationwide prescription cost reduction program, causing more uncertainty and higher costs in rural hospitals.
- Persistently pursue increases to Medicaid reimbursements for health care. Medicaid currently only reimburses at 57% of the actual cost of services, which is one of the main reasons rural hospitals continue to close.
- Champion ending non-compete contracts that prohibit doctors from leaving their place of work to practice elsewhere - such as rural communities.
- Repeal vouchers and fully fund public schools. Money for vouchers take money away from rural public schools, even though many rural communities do not have private schools.
- Continue to fight to implement the Sun Bucks program blocked by Governor Braun. This program provides meals to hungry children in the summer - benefitting both our children and farmers.

- Demand President Trump reimburse farmers for crops lost due to his tariffs and the inability to import fertilizer because of his rogue war.

Freedom

Support Veterans - Hoosier heroes deserve to be honored for their sacrifices, not with empty rhetoric, but with real support from their state and country. Indiana must be a state that prioritizes every veteran's wellbeing.

- Fight the Republican Supermajority in the Statehouse when they decreased veterans' access to the Military Family Relief Fund.
- Require every county to hire a County Service Officer and establish a fund to pay their salaries to ensure Hoosier veterans can access services no matter where in Indiana they live.
- Require discharge counseling for returning veterans to evaluate any needed ongoing services for a successful return to home - and make sure those services are available.
- Fund focused, intensive housing programs for veterans without homes.

Legalize Cannabis - 84% of Hoosiers believe Cannabis should be legal in some form, underscoring that no one in Indiana should go to jail for something legal in 40 states and D.C. Our neighboring states have become the marketplace for Hoosiers and are scooping up millions of our tax dollars. This is critical revenue that could be invested in Indiana. After more than a decade of Republicans ignoring Democrat proposals it is time to bring Indiana into the modern-day.

- Fully legalize Cannabis and create the regulatory framework.
- Record expungement for those with Cannabis-related convictions.

Restore Reproductive Justice - Despite 59% of Hoosiers supporting abortion in all or some cases, the Republican Supermajority in the General Assembly still forced through their extreme abortion ban. While they hold steadfast on reducing women's access to healthcare, 16 hospital obstetrics departments have closed since 2020 and Planned Parenthood announced the closing of two clinics. This has created women's healthcare deserts in 25% of Indiana's 92 counties. As a result, Indiana has the third highest maternal mortality rate in the nation. This is disgraceful. Democrats have vehemently opposed these bans and the loss of funding to Planned Parenthood that drive the closures of critical healthcare centers.

- Restore abortion rights to Roe v. Wade status.

- Restore funding to Planned Parenthood for wellness exams, STI testing and treatment, and birth control.
- Prohibit the public release of reproductive health records.

Live Safely in Communities - Public safety is top of mind for Hoosiers. Gun violence is now the leading cause of death for children, police officer positions remain unfilled, parents are worried about dropping their kids off at school, and public gatherings are mass shooting targets. But this still isn't enough to convince Republicans to take real action to get guns off our streets, incentivize safe storage, support community policing initiatives, or fund youth opportunity programs. Instead, they pour \$170 billion into ICE - more than the budgets for all local and state law enforcement agencies combined - so masked agents can instill fear into neighborhoods and detain people who have never committed a crime. Republicans expanded the role of the Indiana National Guard into policing - despite loud opposition from Hoosiers. These actions don't keep neighborhoods safe or reduce school shootings - they are power grabs meant to instill fear. Democrats in Indiana are steadfast in our approach to protect the 2nd Amendment while also protecting lives.

- Incentivize safe storage in homes to reduce youth access to guns.
- Establish the Indiana Gun Crimes Taskforce, a multi-agency partnership of federal, state, and local law enforcement focused on reducing violent crime in Indiana by seizing thousands of illegal firearms and targeting violent offenders.
- Require schools to provide access to mental health services to help youth struggling with mental health concerns, including suicidal thoughts.
- Increase the age to purchase a gun to 21 and ban the sale of military style automatic weapons.
- Repeal SEA 1 passed by Republicans in 2025 - this bill took millions of dollars away from local communities, meaning less money for police, fire, emergency medical response, libraries, and parks.
- Protect neighborhoods from rogue federal law enforcement by requiring ICE agents to successfully complete deescalation training, wear body cameras, identify themselves, and answer to a third party review board when they use excessive force.

Free from Discrimination - You are not free if the government regulates who you love, supports programs for the one religion it prefers over others, or denies you opportunities because of the color of your skin. Our government is elected to represent all of us. Republican efforts to fund some faith-based initiatives, insert religious texts into schools and disparage certain religions are unconstitutional. Same sex marriage has been upheld by the U.S. Supreme Court yet Republicans refuse to remove the ban from our

statute. Voluntary DEI programs proven to improve workplaces and innovation should not be discouraged or banned. Democrats have always stood for freedom.

- Either stop using taxes to fund faith-based initiatives or make the funding available to all religions.
- Remove the ban on same sex marriage still in Indiana's code.
- Restore DEI programs so every Hoosier has the opportunity to succeed.

Dignity for Immigrants - Indiana Democrats recognize and celebrate the contributions of immigrants to Indiana. - Protect early voting.
- Restore the Voting Rights Act to fully safeguard against election maps that dilute representation and try to silence communities of color.
